# CEO MESSAGE

Dear reader,

My name is Martin Aken Thel Mou Aken. I am the owner and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Jamata Investment Group (JIG) Ltd. First, please allow me to take this opportunity to introduce to you our new company named “Jamata Drilling & Water Supply (JDWS) Ltd” which specialize in borehole drilling and water supply, and to also thank you in advance for your custom and continued support. Currently, there are five (5) independent business entities operating under Jamata Investment Group Ltd in the Republic of South Sudan, namely:

1. Jamata Drilling & Water Supply (JDWS) Ltd, fully operational.
2. Jamata Clearing & Forwarding (JCF) Ltd, fully operational.
3. Jamata Logistics & Supply (JLS) Ltd, partly operational.
4. Jamata Construction (JC) Ltd, partly operational, and
5. Jamata money transfer Agency (M-Gurush), operational.

Jamata Drilling and Water Supply (JDWS) Ltd was registered on 23rd October 2020 as a limited company in the Republic of South Sudan and has been operating through collaboration and sub-contracting to partners in the industry, until we were able to procure our own drilling equipment in 2022 and embarked on digging borehole. Our inaugural borehole was dug in Longe West residential area, Northern Bari Payam, in Juba on 2nd June 2022, and our first staff conference and official launching of the company took place on 9th July 2022 at Yam Hotel in Juba.

Jamata drilling and water supply Ltd is a private enterprise totally owned by South Sudanese, researched, and born out of established need. We are a community-service oriented company that believes in preserving life and livelihoods of our people, as we strongly believe in service provision before profits. We are ready and willing to receive orders and provide exceptional services to individuals, households, communities, private companies, local and international NGOs, and government agencies at affordable prices.

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# WHY WE CREATE JDWS?

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We created JDWS Ltd because there was an established need for such a service in South Sudan, due to lack of sufficient clean drinking water for many communities. Plus, the existing drilling and water supply companies are few, mostly foreign owned, and sometime over charging our people for services rendered. Also, according to UNICEF South Sudan, despite the abundance of rivers in South Sudan, “Fifty-nine per cent (59%) of the population (estimated to be 13 million people) lacks access to safe water. To survive, families are forced to drink dirty water, putting them at risk of many waterborne diseases such as cholera and diarrhoea, which remain the leading causes of death among children in South Sudan. The situation is further aggravated by poor hygiene practices. Just ten per cent (10%) of the population have access to improved sanitation”.

Therefore, providing communities with access to safe / clean drinking water is crucial to sustaining life and livelihoods, and one way of doing this is by drilling boreholes, water wells, erecting water yards, etc. Plus, trucking fresh/clean drinking water to individual households and communities. Our primary objectives include, but not limited to the following:

1. To meet the established need for drilling-boreholes, digging water wells, erecting water yards, and providing clean drinking water through trucking fresh drinking water to households and communities.
2. To engage in community education, incorporating water preservation as a scarce commodity, water treatment, maintenance of good hygiene, waste disposal, and protection of the environment.
3. To bring into the industry a wealth of knowledge and expertise in the water drilling sector, and to be committed to provision of exceptional services to our clients, guided by ethics, professionalism, quality control, cost control, adhering to established norms and standards set by our government, and agreed schedules with clients.
4. To be a leading water drilling company committed to diversity and equality of opportunity, reflected in our recruitment and training of staff. Currently, we have recruited a total of twenty-seven (27) qualified employees (including several females), 12 staff at Headquarters in Juba, and 15 serving in the field.
5. To be consultants on water storage solutions, water yards, suppliers of water storage tanks, water pumps, water transportation, and related activities.

With these few remarks, I encourage you to continue to support our efforts in bringing lasting solutions to water shortage problem and related issues in the Republic of South Sudan, and please accept the assurances of our highest consideration.



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## VISION

To contribute effectively to eradication of scarcity of water supply in South Sudan, and to see our people in rural and urban areas having constant access to sufficient and sustainable water supplies, safe water within reasonable distance of homes, properly managed and affordable.

## MISSION

To become the first-choice company for our customers in providing borehole drilling and water supply services. Dedicating our expertise and resources to achieve exceptional results, driven by professionalism, ethics, and set standards.



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## OUR TRACK RECORD:

We have established a good track record in borehole drilling and provision of fresh drinking water to households and communities. From June – August 2021 the company has implemented a contract for the National Ministry of General Education and Instruction, through commissioning the digging and operationalisation of thirteen (13) boreholes, providing clean drinking water for schools in the following localities in South Sudan:

- (a) 6 Schools in Western Bahr El Ghazal State,
- (b) 4 Schools in Warrap State, and
- (c) 3 School in Central Equatoria State.

### Our Current Projects:

Effective from July – December 2022, the company is on track to complete the drilling and operationalisation of fifteen (15) boreholes, including the erecting of fifteen (15) Steel-Tank Water Storage Facilities (water Yards) in schools in the following localities in South Sudan:

- (a) 4 Schools in Lakes State,
- (b) 4 Schools in Warrap State,
- (c) 2 Schools in Northern Bahr Alghazal State,
- (d) 2 Schools in Western Bahr El Ghazal State,
- (e) 1 School in Greater Pibor Administrative Area,
- (f) 1 School in Eastern Equatoria State, and
- (g) 1 School in Abyei Administrative Area.



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## OUR PLANNED PROJECTS:



Besides the Thirteen operational boreholes done in 2021, and Fifteen Water Yards to be concluded during the second half of 2022, JDWS Ltd has scheduled the drilling of additional seventy-four (73) boreholes in schools in the following localities in South Sudan during the physical year 2022 – mid-2023:

- (a) 13 Schools in Northern Bahr El Ghazal State,
- (b) 13 Schools in Lakes State,
- (c) 8 Schools in Jonglei State,
- (d) 7 Schools in Upper Nile State,
- (e) 6 Schools in Western Equatoria State,
- (f) 6 Schools in Unity State,
- (g) 6 Schools in Warrap State,
- (h) 5 Schools in Western Bahr El Ghazal State,
- (i) 3 Schools in Central Equatoria State,
- (j) 2 Schools in Eastern Equatoria State,
- (k) 2 Schools in Greater Pibor Administrative Area, and
- (l) 2 Schools in Ruweng Administrative Area.

One of our planned projects is to establish a

Bottled-Water Factory to produce and distribute distilled water at affordable prices to schools, hospitals, individual households, local neighbourhoods, local businesses, government entities, etc. across the Republic of South Sudan.

### Our Initial Investment:

To demonstrate our commitment and drive to be the best company in borehole drilling and water provision business, we have invested significant amount of funds on setting-up the company, including the procurement of the following work-related items and equipment:

We bought a land measuring 40x40 in Longe West residential area, Northern Bari Payam in Juba, and constructed a three-meter-high fence on the said land to be used as company's headquarters.

We bought ten 20ft steel containers and pre-positioned them inside the company's compound to be used as initial storage facilities, until we construct our own purpose build warehouse.

We bought a state-of-the-art underground Water Detection Machine (River G 3D) to enable us search for water efficiently.

We bought an assortment of protective equipment and clothing for thirty of our field workers.

We bought one heavy-duty drilling machine mounted

on a big vehicle, and one small mobile drilling machine, pulled by a support vehicle.

We bought one big transporter vehicle for carrying assortment of drilling supplies to the field, and four Toyota pickup double-cabins to be utilised as field support vehicles.

We bought three water-tank vehicles for supplying fresh drinking water to neighbourhoods.

We bought nineteen complete sets of stainless-steel water storage tanks (water yards), and thousands of pieces of assortment of pipes for the drilling-work, i.e., 140mm UPVC casing pipes, 14mm UPVC screen pipes, 200mm UPVC casing pipes, plus, other spare parts of complete sets of necessary borehole equipment.

Plus, we have organised a one-day staff-workshop to discuss about our borehole drilling and water supply business, staff welfare, health and safety and other related issues. Plus, we have plans for continued staff training. We are now active on the field and ready to expand our business during the period from 2022 to 2025 through more sourced investment, and through injecting profits back into company's operations to ensure sustainability into the future.

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# OUR PRODUCTS & SERVICES:

Besides specialising in borehole digging and provision of clean drinking water to individual households and communities, Jamata Drilling and Water Supply (JDWS) Ltd has setup a one-stop-shop at its headquarters in Juba, in collaboration with partners in the industry to cater for customer's needs and after service requirements. For example, JDWS Ltd can:

- (a) Supply of new water hand pump, electrical pump, solar submersible pump, borehole cleaning/flushing and maintenance, borehole rehabilitation and related work.
- (b) Supply of portable water pump generators.
- (c) Supply of water storage tanks (stainless-steel or plastic), and consulting on water storage & management solutions.
- (d) Supply and installation of solar powered water pumps, and utilisation of renewable energy in general.
- (e) Supply of assortment of spare parts, including the use of our all-terrain 4x4 Toyota Land Cruiser 70 Series vehicles to ferry or deliver spare parts to clients. Plus, provision of logistical support to clients, including the hiring-out of our support vehicles as appropriate.

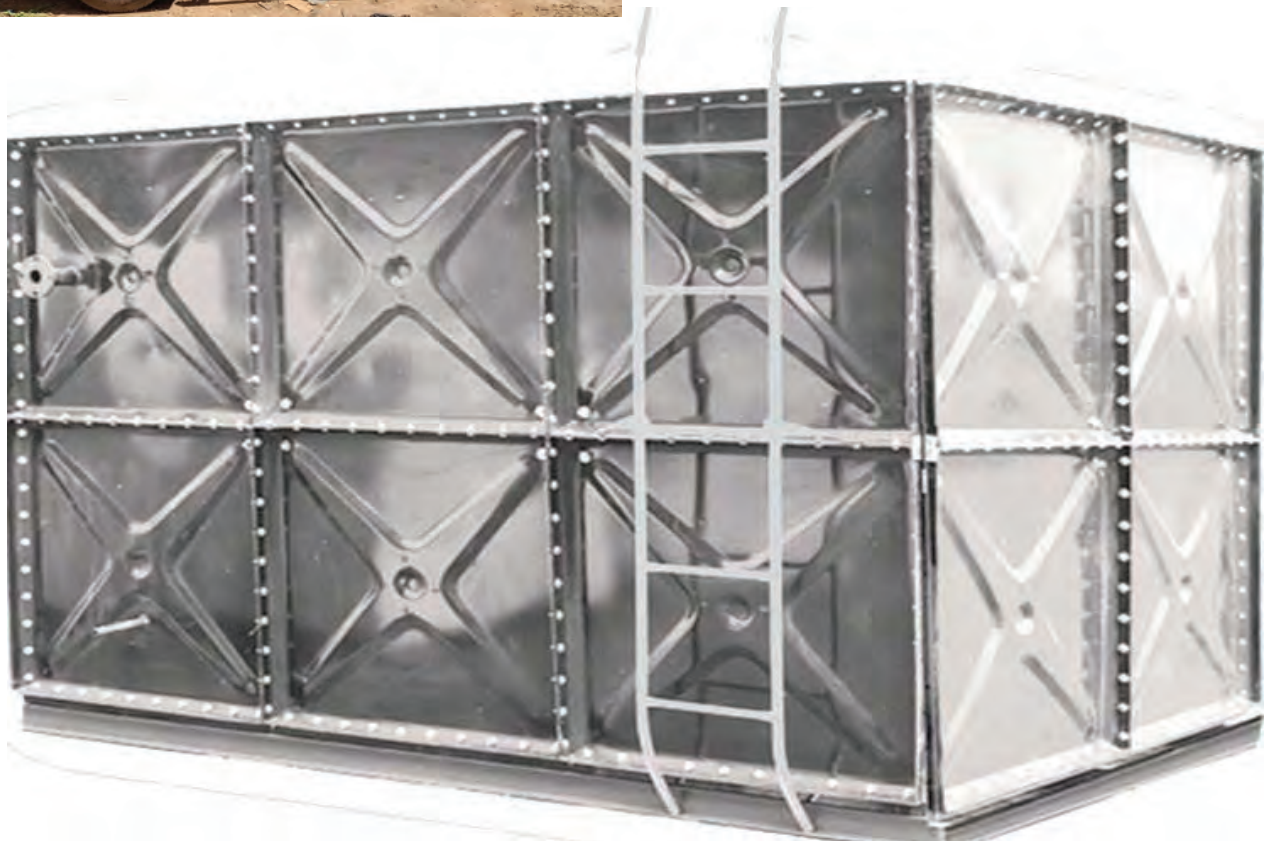
